## **NSS Annual Report- 2021-22**

The NSS unit of Shankar Narayan College organised various activities during the academic year 2021-22. Our college has 03 NSS unit comprising of 03 Programme Officers and 300 volunteers. The activities conducted include Health and hygiene, Environment Conservation, Celebration of important days, Pledge relating various social issues, etc in accordance to the guidelines and circulars issued from University of Mumbai, Central Government, State Government and local authorities. All the activities have undertaken under the guidance of Respected Principal-Dr. V N Yadav, with the support of college Management and regular co-operation from Area Coordinator- Prof. Aruna Gujar. Brief report of the activities undertaken are as follows:

### **Donation to Flood affected districts**

27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2021

NSS unit set counters for collection of groceries, other dry snacks, medicines as well as clothes for donation to flood prone disastrous Mahad and Chiplun districts of Maharashtra. With the support of residents of Bhayander, NSS unit could collect good amount of required food articles and emergency items and boarded for flood affected area. Around 20 volunteers participated in this activity.

### **NSS Orientation**

24<sup>th</sup> December 2021

NSS orientation Programme was organised for newly enrolled NSS volunteers for academic year 2021-22. The orientation was conducted by Ms. Deepa Dalvi, NSS District co-ordinator, Palghar. She explained origin of NSS, significance of NSS Logo, NSS activities and its benefit to the volunteers and overall development of the country. This orientation was attended by 17 females and 20 males ensuring COVID safety measures.

### **Health and Hygiene (14 Activities)**

1. 13<sup>th</sup> May and 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2021

Online awareness and training programme held by NGOs- United way, UNICEF, in partnership with NSS cell, Maharashtra. Total 40 volunteers attended training on 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 and 42 volunteers attended on 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2021. They learned how to create digital awareness regarding Pandemic COVID 19 and virtually facilitate information about vaccinations in the society.

3. 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2021

Online Quiz on Blood Donation Awareness Campaign held by NSS Unit, Siddharth College of Arts, Science & Commerce. 08 volunteers- 05 females and 03 males participated in the campingn.

4. 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2021

11 volunteers- 07 females and 04 males attended Webinar on 'National Yoga Day' organised NSS unit of Siddharth College of Arts, Science & Commerce.

5. 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2021

The NSS unit organised Mega blood donation camp on 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2021. The blood bank of JJ government Hospital and Nair, BMC hospital visited. In this camp total 89 blood bags were collected. The target of highest blood bags collection set by University of Mumbai in the phase of COVID 19 pandemic was achieved by collecting 89 bags by our NSS unit. Dr. Sudhir Puranik, Director, NSS cell, University of Mumbai appreciated the efforts of all NSS units of affiliated colleges on the same day.

6. 21<sup>st</sup> September, 2021

02 volunteers-01 female and 01 male participated in "Hands Only CPR" demonstration conducted by Department of Emergency Medicine and Trauma Care, Wockhardt Hospital , Mira Road Hospital. They gain awareness regarding essential steps to be taken for patient who suffers sudden cardiac attack.

7. 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2021

05 volunteers- 03 female and 02 male participated in Webinar on 'World Mental Healthy Day' organised by NSS Unit, Bhavans College, Mumbai.

8. 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2022

NGOs United way, UNICEF in partnership with NSS cell, Maharashtra conducted 03 months virtual campaign for spreading awareness about COVID 19. Timely report of the virtual dissemination of awareness on Covid appropriate behaviour and availability of vaccination were sent on regular basis by our Programme officer- Dr. Shital Khadakkar as and when asked by said NGOs. For this campaign 82 volunteers attended training programme and among these 38 volunteers received participation certificates.

9. 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2021

10 volunteers- 05 females and 05 males attended National Webinar ' End Inequalities, End Aids' on the occasion of World HIV-AIDS Day organised by NSS unit and Red Ribbon club of S.M. Shetty College of Science, Commerce and Management studies.

10. 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2021

15 Volunteers- 07 females and 08 males attended Webinar on 'Say no to Narcoterrorism' organised by NSS Unit of Bhavan's College, Andheri, Mumbai. The volunteers were educated about the adverse effect of narcotics consumption.

13. 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2022

A training programme for Pulse polio vaccination drive was conducted by Primary Health Centre, Navghar, Mira-Bhayander Municipal Corporation. In this training the volunteers were informed about how to vaccinate child and outreach activity including community survey. 44 volunteers attended the training.

14. 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2022

A pledge 'Say Yes to Life and No to drugs' was conducted by Narcotics Control Bureau, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India. Total 16 volunteers- 06 females and 10 males took the pledge.

15. 27<sup>th</sup> February -4<sup>th</sup> March 2022

In Pulse polio vaccination drive about 7,000 houses were surveyed and among those approximately 3,500 children were vaccinated by our volunteers. 16 females and 08 males volunteers involved in the pulse polio vaccination drive.
