

Annual Report 2018-2019

The Gandhian Studies Centre of our college had organised various events to celebrate 150th birth anniversary of 'Father of Nation' - Gandhiji. The programmes conducted were A tribute to Gandhiji on his birthday; Mega Peace Rally; Swatch Bharat activity; Seminar on 'Gandhiji's Experiential Learning -Need of the hour'; Homage to Gandhiji on his death anniversary; Exhibition of posters, portraits, sketches and slogans on Gandhian thoughts and students participation in the seminar on 'Gandhi and present day India 'conducted at neighbour college -Abhinav College of Arts and Commerce.

Activities on 150th birthday of Gandhiji

2nd October 2018:

- 1) The program was began with introductory speech of Commissioner, Mira-Bhayandar on youth and Gandhiji's principle.
- 2) A peace rally was conducted from our college to Bhayandar Railway Station in the morning hours between 8:00am to 9:30am. There were about 250 participants including Chairperson of the institute Shri Rohidasji Patil, other management supporting staff, students and teaching staff of the college. In the rally placards held by the students which conveyed messages on Gandhian thoughts and idealism. The Baggage police extended their support to conduct rally peacefully. The rally dispersed at Bhayandar station.
- 3) The Western Railway Staff of Bhayandar Station had organised 'swachh Bharat ' activity. This session was conducted by co-ordinated efforts of Gandhian studies Centre of our college and Railway staff.

3rd October 2018

On 3rd October a seminar was organised on 'Gandhiji's Experiential Learning -Need of the hour. The resource person called for this seminar was Dr. Masarrat Sahib Ali, Govt of Maharashtra (BEd) College and also ex-member of the Prime Minister 'S High Level Committee for Minorities'. She delivered lecture on evolution of Mr. Mohan Karamchand Gandhi to Mahatma Gandhi. Impact of his life experiences in revolution for freedom. The significance of adopting truth, non violence and thereby peace especially in youth life. Around 89 students attended this seminar.

30th January 2019

- On the death anniversary of the bapuji an exhibition was arranged to pay homage to him. The students participated in the exhibition by drawing sketches, portraits, posters of Gandhiji and related historical events and informative slogans based on Gandhiji's idealism. There were around 65 posters exhibited in this event to pay homage. All the management , teaching staff and around 250 students visited this exhibition thus paying homage to Gandhiji.
