In-house students seeking admission for **First Year - B.Sc. (Information Technology), B.Sc. (Computer Science), B.Com (Banking & Insurance), B.Com. (Accounting & Finance), B.Com. (Financial Market) and B.Com. (Management Studies)** Courses in this college are requested to submit their **college admission form** (college website www.sncollege.com) along with **pre-admission online enrollment form** duly filled along with **undertaking** which is registered on website <http://muugadmission.samarth.edu.in>

Mobile no. filled in both the **college admission form** and **pre-admission online enrollment form** should be same.

All admissions to the First Year of Degree Programs and their Academic activities will be as per the provisions and guidelines of NEP 2020 issued by Government of Maharashtra, University of Mumbai and University Grant Commission from time to time.

1. A candidate being eligible for admission to **First Year B.Sc. (Information Technology)** should have passed **45% open category** and **40% marks for reserved category** along with **Mathematics subject**.
2. Admission for **B.Sc. (Computer Science)** will be given to the students those who passed HSC science with **Mathematics subjects**.
3. A candidate being eligible for admission to the **B.Com (Banking & Insurance), B.Com. (Accounting & Finance), B.Com. (Financial Market) and B.Com. (Management Studies)** should have passed HSC examination with First attempt with **45% marks for open category and 40% marks for reserve category**.
4. **Direct admission for First Year B.Sc.(Information Technology), B.Sc.(Computer Science), and B.Com. (Financial Market)** courses.
5. Those students have scored **60% and above** shall be given direct admission to First Year Bachelor of Commerce in Banking & Insurance (**F.Y.B.B.I.**) and **First Year Bachelor of Commerce (Management Studies)** course directly. They should pay their fees immediately and confirmed their admission.
6. Students those who have scored **70% and above** shall be given direct admission to First Year Bachelor of Commerce in Accounting & Finance (**F.Y.B.A.F.**). They should pay their fees immediately and confirmed their admission.
7. All students should use their mobile number as **USER NAME** and surname as **PASSWORD** for online admission registration process.
8. Students should note that after **paying Rs. 100/- admission form** fee through online payment gateway. The admission form would be **available on college website for filling** and onward uploading on college website to aspirants.
9. Students should **pay their fees after Document Verification** at college office (**6th Floor, Pravin Patil college of Engineering building**)
10. **Direct admission** will start from **19th May 2026 to 25th May 2026 at 10:00 a.m. to 01:00 pm.**



11. Students should **pay their fees** through **online Payment** Gateway on college website and download hard copy of the fee receipt and produce in the college office while resuming college.
12. **Students who pays fee through RuPay Card need not pay Transaction Charges and Tax.**
13. Students are requested to visit college and University of Mumbai website regularly for updation.
