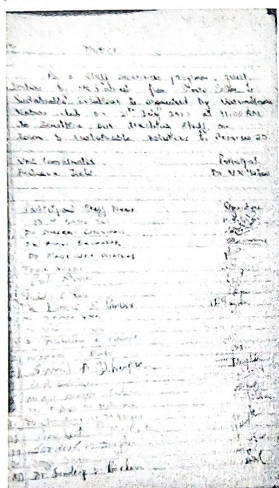

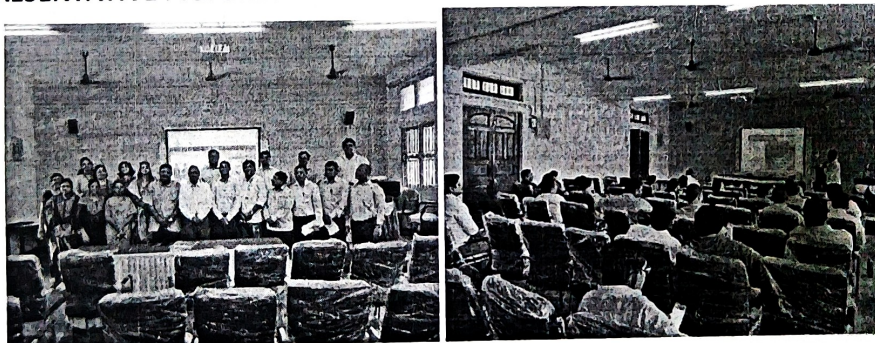

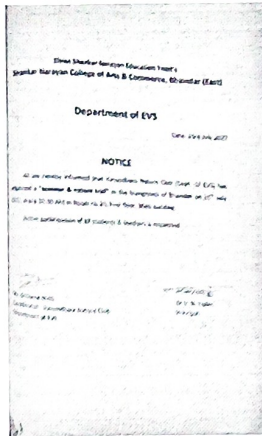
A BRIEF FIVE LINER WRITEUP:

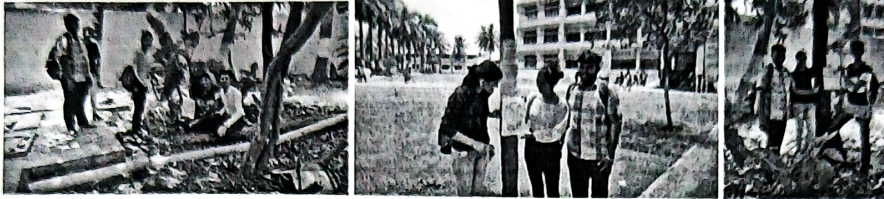

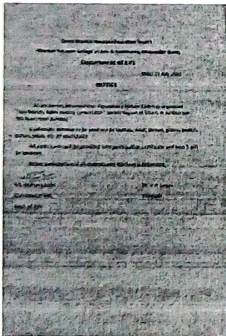
A BRIEF FIVE LINER WRITEUP:

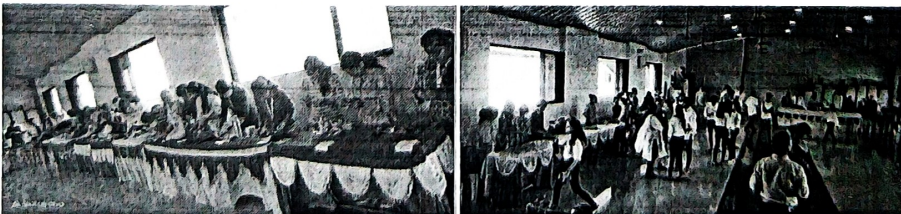

25th August: in order to make people aware about harmful effects of Plaster-of-paris and synthetic paints & plastic materials used for decorating idols of Ganesha during Ganeshotsave, our students organised a Ecofriendly Ganesha Modeling workshop to train students and teachers in the art of sculpting using environment friendly material. We encouraged participant to use only biodegradable materials for clay modeling & decorating it. Further, our students used seeds to decorate the idols they sculpted with seeds like fenugreek, mustard, coriander, cumin etc which when immersed in water, would help plant trees after the Earth clay models have dissolved in the pot.

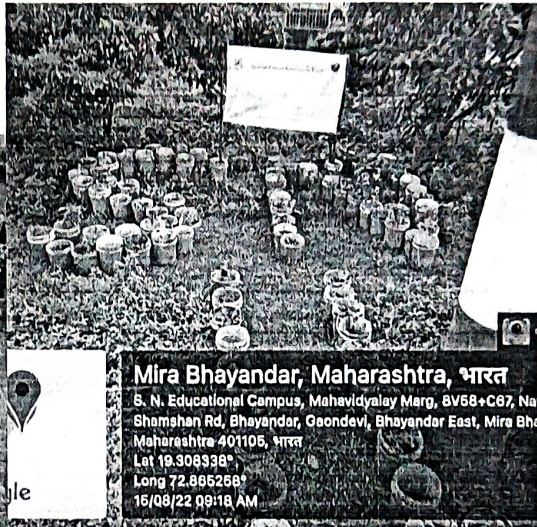



15th August 2022

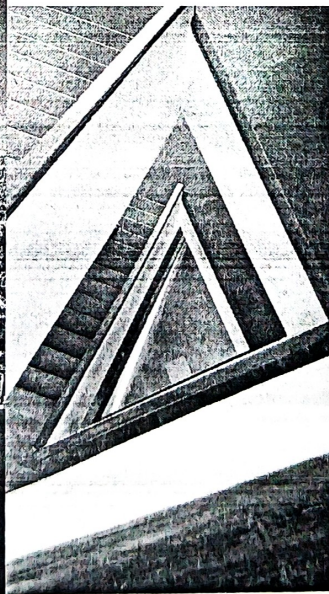

Vasundhara Nature Club chose the event of Cultural celebration in the campus to spread the message far and wide through their Mother-Earth figurine covered with E-waste and draped it in discarded clothes, aiming to educate the audience about reducing the apparel waste & recycle the Electronic waste.



Nature Photography Contest: photography talent of our students was revealed through this nature photography contest. Pictures in 3 categories: Flora, Fauna & campus were captured artistically using mobile phones by our students. 35+ students sent their entries who were judged and awarded with certificates on 21st March 2023. Waste-To-Gold lecture on 3rd December: Hands-on training to students on how to make compost from organic/wet waste generated at home was organized. Presentation followed by hands on training was given to the interested 25 students & 2 teachers.

Campus Survey of flora & fauna in February 2023: In order to generate a database and enforce nature conservation in campus, students of Nature club and other motivated students from FyBcom, SYbcom & self finance surveyed the campus to record the variety & count of flora (fruit, flower, non-flowering trees & plants) & fauna (animals, birds, and insects) in the campus.

Nature club students formed an active group of contributors to the Green Audit Committee for data collection for Energy, Green & water audit of our college campus.
