How to Prepare For Airport Security

- Empty your pockets
- Wear very little metal
- Keep medications and medical supplies separate
- Wear socks and easy-to-remove shoes
- Place liquids & gels in a Ziploc Bag
- Prepare laptops for screening
- Keep your ID handy
- Remain calm and attentive

If stored in containers with capacities not exceeding 100 (g) and kept in a resealable transparent plastic bag (or a "Zip-lock" bag) with a capacity of not more than 1 liter, liquids can be brought on board the aircraft.
