“ Matt Bannick (CEO, Omidyar Network) was preoccupied as he made his morning cup of tea. He looked forward to his upcoming visit to ON's India office but realized there was no easy resolution to the issue at hand. It was to discuss Anudip Foundation, an opportunity that seemed to fit many of the investment characteristics ON sought.
